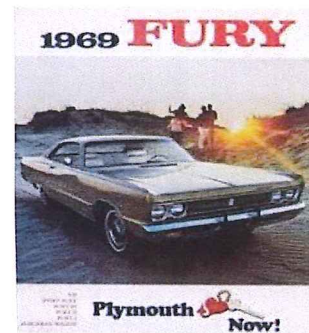

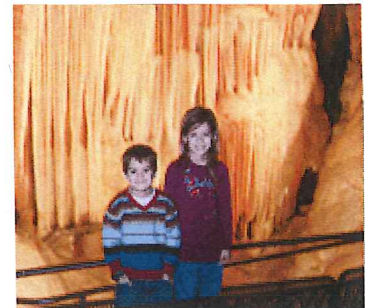
Hotel amenities include free continental breakfast, outdoor pool, and 24-hour business center. All rooms come with refrigerators and microwaves, plus complimentary wireless internet access.

Thursday, September 12

Check-in at Host Hotel. "Meet & Greet" in the hospitality room and pick up registration packets. Car wash facility is available within 1-block of hotel. Dinner on your own with several restaurants conveniently located within a few blocks of hotel.

Friday, September 13

In the morning we will drive to Meramec Caverns in Stanton, MO, on Old US Route 66, for a tour of Missouri's largest commercial cave. Meramec Caverns is known as Missouri's Buried Treasure and as Jesse James Hideout. Guided tours are given every 30 minutes on well lighted walkways. See the beautiful and complex mineral formations. A fee of \$17.00 per person will be paid for a group tour at the cave. After a stop for lunch, we will be driving back on Old US Route 66 through St. Clair, and then on back roads to Catawissa, MO, for a visit with Clay Kossuth. Clay and his sons are Mopar Racers and have an extensive collection of Mopar memorabilia and parts cars.



Saturday, September 14

In the morning we will be driving to Owensville, MO, to view the car collection of Mike Riefer, who has a couple of Superbirds and also some Professional Cars and memorabilia. For our afternoon activity we will travel down to Cuba, MO, for a tour of Bob's Gasoline Alley. A buffet lunch will be served by Bob's wife, Darlene. Then we will tour Bob's collection of Historic Route 66 gasoline memorabilia, largest in the Midwest. Included are old gas pumps, neon lighted signs, die cast toy autos and trucks, and signage.
